It has been a few months now since the Base has held a meeting, first because of Veterans Day (planned) and then the 2017 Snow Storm in December (Yea, right!), so I thought I would at put together this News and Upcoming Events paper to keep everyone informed.

Let us remember our shipmates who gave their lives in pursuit of their duties while serving their country, that their dedication, deeds, and supreme sacrifice will be a constant source of motivation toward greater accomplishments, and also honor our Shipmates on active duty in the service of the first line of defense of our Nation with a moment of silence.

#### **Boats lost during the month of December were:**

**USS Capelin (SS-289):** Lost on Dec 2, 1943 with the loss of 76 men. She was on her 1st war patrol. Her exact location and cause of loss remain unknown.

**USS Sealion (SS-195):** Lost on Dec 10, 1941 with the loss of 4 men. To prevent her from falling into enemy hands, she was scuttled in Manila Bay after incurring severe bomb damage during the initial Japanese attack. One other crew member was later captured and died in a POW camp.

**USS F-1 / Carp (SS-20):** Lost on December 17, 1917 with the loss of 19 officers and men when it was sunk after a collision with the USS F-3 (Pickerell) (SS-22) off San Clemente, CA.

**USS S-4 (SS-109):** Lost on December 17, 1927 with the loss of 40 officers and men when it was sunk after being rammed by USCG destroyer Paulding. She was salvaged in 1928 and recommissioned.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

- News from USSVI:
  - The 2018-2019 Academic Year Scholarship application package has been posted on the USSVI.org Website and may be downloaded. The Scholarship page is found by ng the Charitable Fund section, then Scholarship Tab, Then Application Tab all located on the left side of the home page of USSVI.ORG. The three documents located in the Scholarship Application page must be downloaded. Interested sponsors and applicants are encouraged to read through the instruction and procedure document followed by the application form and then the guidance pages to ensure they understand the process and the due dates for the submissions and supporting documentation.
  - First call for Nominations for the 2018 National Officer Elections
    - 2018 is an election year and the following National Officer positions are available:
      - National Commander- Nominees for National Commander must have completed at least two years as a voting member of the Board of Directors by the time they take office as National Commander.
      - National Senior Vice Commander- Nominees for Senior Vice-Commander must have completed at least two years as a Member of the Board of Directors, and must certify that they have or will develop a working familiarity of the USSVI bookkeeping software.
      - National Junior Vice Commander Nominees for Junior Vice-Commander must have completed at least two years as a Member of the Board of Directors.
      - National Treasurer Must be a Regular member in good standing and Nominees for National Treasurer must have some experience in bookkeeping, certify that they have, or will develop a working knowledge of the USSVI approved bookkeeping software, use the USSVI approved software as part of his/her duties as National Treasurer, and cannot change to another software package without the Board of Director's approval.
      - National Secretary Must be a Regular member in good standing.
      - Regional Director Must be a member in good standing of a Base within the Region.

- The Tim VeArd Free USSVI Base websites that are part of the present USSVI Database WILL NOT BE PART OF THE NEW SYSTEM. The main reason is the cost to reformat them and write new software to edit and control them. You will have about a month to down load photos, patches, boat photo, and articles etc. from your USSVI Base website so you can make a GO Daddy site or other site of your own.

He has both diseases and knows something about the issue. Neither of these ailments can be treated, so you may as well get the money. Additionally, you may get an indicator on whether of not you have Mesothelioma. That will eventually require a biopsy and is worth the big bucks, and if you have it, you are probably a shortimer.
