 - The CLAMAGORE is not going anywhere since Patriots Point has found that the cost of reefing the submarine is very close to the cost of repair and has used the funds it had received to help finance some positions, they felt they could no longer afford to keep. CRAMA is working on a proposal on how they can help maintain the submarine.

- The CDR stated that had received a late email indicating one of the delinquent members would be renewing his membership which updated the delinquent members to 1 for National and 2 for Base.

The **KAPS 4 KIDS** Chairman, Steve Bishop, provided the following:

- The National K4K Chairman, John P. Riley, had provided Steve with information that Groton base was conducting visits virtually via Zoom by providing an iPad to the hospital and using PowerPoint presentations.
- Steve indicated that INOVA could not accept gifts like an iPad. All gifts need to be received by their corporate headquarters.
 - o Brian Haller stated that tablets were less expensive than iPads and the Base might consider purchasing tablets and loan them to hospitals to conduct virtual K4K visits.
 - The Base CDR requested that Steve Bishop research this idea and report back to the EXCOM.
 - Steve Jaeger provided that if this proposal were accepted, the Base would need to develop an inventory process to account for the items.
- While the Base would not be applying for WALMART grants for 2021, grant procedures had changed and all WALMART grants would now be processed by the USSVI National Treasurer, Ken Earls. This change is required for providing appropriate tax ID to WALMART.
- T. Michael Bircumshaw was stepping down as the National Editor for the *American Submariner* magazine.
 - Les Altschuler provided that the new editor is Chuck Senior who has decades of experience.





The **STOREKEEPER**, Howard Chatham, reported:

- Storekeeper has USSVI NOVA challenge coins, submarine stickers, and USSVI NOVA Base patches available for purchase.

 postpone because of COVID-19. The CDR mentioned that the USSVI National
 Convention website states the host resort has reopened and is taking reservations;
 however, the Convention Committee is unable to develop a registration form because of
 the events vendors' status.
- Work has begun on the new National website; extremely complicated; no estimate as to when the work will be complete.
