Logan Foley

- Lead for SSP interface management process (i.e. Coordination) and liaison with NAVSEA regarding Ship interfaces with SSBN Strategic Weapons System

- 2020-present: Joined SSP in Systems Engineering and Integration Branch (SP2012)

- Played in drumline in Notre Dame Marching Band; currently lead ND Alumni Band drum section in DC
- 3 daughters ages 14, 12, 10 (all involved in competitive athletics, coding, and marching band)
- Logan's complete Powerpoint briefing will be available on the USSVI NOVA Base website.

The following is a summary of his presentation:

- Logan is in Special Projects office 201255
- He started with a history of the SSBN mission and submarines
 - o "Peace through Strength" was Ronald Reagan's motto
 - o Deterrence is a game of strategy
 - VADM Wolf is the current head of SP, and he says that the SLBM's have 70% of the nation's warheads
 - o The ESGN is the world's most accurate navigation system − it is still operational on the Ohio Class today, having operated on subs since 1978.
 - In 1956 RADM Red Raborn led the Special Projects Office.
 - o From Presidential proclamation to first Polaris shot from the USS George Washington (SSBN 598) took just over 4 years. Imagine dong that in today's contracting bureaucracy!!
 - o Today the Columbia class is being built to deliver in 2028. In parallel, the Trident D5 Life Extension program is underway.
 - o STRATCOM is the Battle Commander for SP
 - o We have always worked well with our UK Navy partners
 - The UK Dreadnaught program is the UK version of the Columbia class. They each will have a common missile compartment.



- o Today the first four Ohio class are SSGNs. Each SSGN is capable of carrying up to 154 Tomahawk land-attack cruise missiles. The missiles are loaded in seven-shot Multiple-All-Up-Round Canisters (MACs) in up to 22 missile tubes.
- Logan's job is the weapons system interface with all submarine systems – "CONFIGURATION CONTROL ON STEROIDS"
- He says he is a glorified marriage counselor between and among various industry and government partners
- Currently the Navy and SP have started, and are now transitioning to, a digital engineering environment where models, instead of 2-Dimensional drawings, will be the normal situation for decision making.
- Toyota has advised the Navy that it took them 7 years to transition to the fully digital world.

After Logan's presentation, Base VCDR George Wallace thanked him and presented him with a USSVI NOVA BASE challenge coin.
