The Kap(SS) 4 Kid(SS) Program is part of the United States Submarine Veterans Charitable Foundation, the charitable arm of the United States Submarine Veterans, Inc. The goal of the program is to visit children with serious medical issues to let them and their families know that there are people who care and are thinking about them.

The submarine veterans of the USSVI Northern Virginia Base have partnered with Inova Children's Hospital in Fairfax VA, University of Virginia Medical Center in Charlottesville VA, and Walter Reed Military Medical Center in Bethesda MD. We visit the pediatric oncology wards and infusion centers several times a year spending time with the children and their support teams, presenting them with Honorary Submariner caps and certificates, submarine coloring books, and other submarine related items including setting up a small library of books on what life on a submarine is like and how submarines are made and operated.
